From the Pastor ~ ~

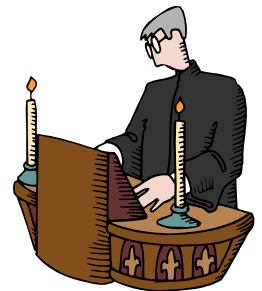
God wants us to use wisdom to make right choices, and the Holy Spirit will lead us into wisdom if we simply ask Him to do so.

Chris Johnson, President, called the meeting to order, welcomed Kent Krimmel to the Council as Member-at-Large and asked Pastor Daene to say a prayer.
