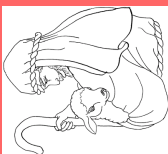

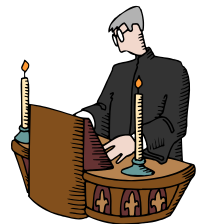


From the Pastor ~ ~

Church Council Highlights ~ ~

The Good Shepherd Church Council met on June 12, 2022 after the worship service. Those in attendance were: Kent Krimmel, Gerda Martin, Michelle Walker, Pastor Daene, Johannah Pollert, Kevin Weber, Amy Houck, Chris Johnson, Randy Powers, Heidi Baca and Rose Krimmel. Those absent were: Dan Bonham, Larry Hill, Don Haddock and Shelley Hill.

Johannah Pollert, Secretary, presented the minutes to be reviewed from our April meeting and they were approved as submitted.

Rose Krimmel, Financial Secretary, presented the offerings for April as \$25,202.31 and May as \$17,558.64. Also, received \$5,658.68 towards the mortgage on the 29th.

Larry Hill, Treasurer, was absent but had submitted his report for May. Expenses for May were \$16,280.34.

Pastor Daene stated that two were confirmed the first Sunday in May. At present we do not have anyone of the age to start classes.

Kevin Weber, Deacon Chairman, no report.

Don Haddock, Trustee Chairman, no report.

Heidi Baca, Christian Education, reported VBS went good. They had 8 children and 3 Helpers (older children). The Summer Sunday School will be in one class like we have done in the past.

Shelley Hill, Stewardship Chairman, no report.

Michelle Walker, Missions Chair, stated we donated 102 pounds of canned fruits and vegetables to the InterChurch Food Pantry in May. Also, we have not had

anyone asking for a ride to church. The sign-up sheet is on the bulletin board in the hallway.

Gerda Martin, Board of Fellowship-Special Events, reported we had a Confirmation Reception for the two confirmands and about 20 or so stayed for the Pitch-In on the 29th. In June we will have a graduation reception for Nicholas Coy.

Members-at-Large Randy Powers stated he is reviewing the Constitution and By-Laws as the Council members are to be doing also. Kent announced he will be cooking the Hot Dogs for LWGS on July 3rd for watching the fireworks from our parking lot. We will be selling the hot dogs & chips and passing out free water. Money earned will go to the Mortgage Fund.
