Church Council Highlights ~~

GSLC Church Council met on August 14, 2022 after the worship service. Those in attendance were: Michelle Walker, Shelley Hill, Heidi Baca, Johannah Pollert, Kevin Weber, Pastor Daene, Gerda Martin, Don Haddock, Larry Hill, Chris Johnson, Randy Powers, and Rose Krimmel. Those absent were Dan Bonham and Kent Krimmel.

Chris Johnson, President called the meeting to order and asked Pastor Daene to say a prayer.

The minutes of our last meeting on June 12, 2022 were presented by the Secretary, Johannah Pollert. A motion was made by Michelle Walker that we accept the minutes as presented. Motion carried.

Financial Secretary, Rose Krimmel gave the income (combination of offerings, Sunday School, and miscellaneous) for June was \$32,947.81 and for July it was \$20,312.83. Included in those totals is the money given for the reduction of our mortgage in the amount of \$22,302.50. Our YTD total contributed as of July 31, 2022 to help pay off

our mortgage is \$27,961.18.

Larry Hill, Treasurer gave the Expenses for June as \$15,299.04 and July as \$16,272.39.

Pastor Daene stated the average attendance for July was 53. He had 5 worship services; 9 Bible studies; 14 Counseling sessions; 3 Member visits; 3 visiting the visitors; and he was here for the July 3rd fireworks.

Kevin Weber, Deacon Chairman, no report.

Don Haddock, Trustee Chairman, no report. Will be scheduling replacing some lightbulbs, cleaning gutters, and etc.

Board of Education Chair, Heidi Baca reported that during July Johannah Pollert taught the younger children lessons about Christian values. The older children have been working on a model of King Herrod's temple. A meeting will be scheduled soon to plan for Fall Sunday School. Stewardship Chair, Shelley Hill had no report.

Michelle Walker, Missions Chair reported members of GSLC donated 126 pounds of Ketchup, Mustard, Relish, and Mayonaise for the InterChurch Food Pantry.

Board of Fellowship, Gerda Martin had no report.

Randy Powers, Member-at-Large is working with a committee reviewing the Constitution and By-Laws.

The Planning Committee will be meeting in October to layout a tentative calendar of events for 2023.

New Business: It was suggested we start having assigned Greeters again. We need a volunteer to be in charge of this. Anyone interested see Rose about getting it started.

Our next meeting will be September 11th. Reports due in the office by September 7. Meeting was closed by saying the Lord's Prayer.
